Changes to policy and strategy, and how that influences 'what' we want to monitor (eg including measuring levels of physical activity or economic expenditure).

Changes to technology - including increased use of web-surveys, social media, gps, digital photography. How this influences 'how' we monitor, and the implications for bias and representation of different recreation groups.

Balancing the needs for 'longitudinal trend monitoring' and 'responding to changes in policy and technology'.

The morning will be on National monitoring of participation in the outdoors.

The afternoon will have two main aspects of the main themes at more local level.
